US pipeline accidents since 2010:

2010 – 28 pipeline accidents

2011 – 30 pipeline accidents

2012 – 36 pipeline accidents

2013 – 29 pipeline accidents

2014 – 4 pipeline accidents (as of Feb.2014)

That's a total of 127 pipeline accidents!

Hazardous Materials!



Knifley, KY (2-13-2014): A natural gas pipeline exploded in Adair County, destroying two homes, causing an evacuation of 20 residents, and blasting a 60-foot crater into the ground near Highway 76.



Dilliner, PA (2-11-2014): One worker has been injured and another is missing after a natural gas well explosion and fire in southwestern Pennsylvania. Crews at the scene report that intense flames have kept them from getting too close to the well.



Enka, NC (1-10-2014): A gas pipeline ruptured, causing a large explosion and fire. Several vehicles were reported to be on fire near the scene, and two businesses and several homes suffered heat damage.

Spectra Energy's "Safety Record":

Spectra Energy has a poor record in regard to the maintenance and monitoring of its pipelines.

Spectra Energy has been fined > \$15 million for spills at 89 pipeline sites.

Spectra Energy has been responsible for > \$8 million in property damage.
